TERMS OF REFERENCE – CURRICULUM COMMITTEE

2023-24

1. To advise the governing body on its statutory obligations regarding the Curriculum.
2. To consider all curriculum policy documents and to report to the governing body on whether they have been adopted.
3. With the assistance of staff, to provide information on how the curriculum is taught, evaluated and resourced.
4. To review the policy and provision for Relationships and Sex education (RSE).
5. To ensure that the requirements for children with Special Educational Needs (SEND) are met.
6. To ensure that the school meets the requirements of the Equality Act 2010, and to report on measures taken by the school to ensure that pupils with disabilities are treated no less favourably than other pupils.
7. To contribute to the curriculum component of the School Improvement Plan or post-Ofsted Action Plan, and to monitor its implementation.
8. To receive reports from the head teacher and other staff on the delivery of the National Curriculum, including testing and assessment arrangements, and to review the published information about school performance.
9. To review the relevant annual Key Stage targets for pupil achievement, and report these to the full governing body.
10. To consider complaints relating specifically to the curriculum and to advise the governing body.
11. To attend or commission appropriate governor training.
12. To report to the full governing body at each of its meetings.
