Weather Forecasts

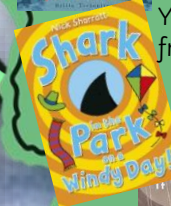
Weather forecasters use symbols on maps to tell us what the weather will be like where we live. Design weather symbols for different sorts of weather:
