### Cornettos at the Colosseum

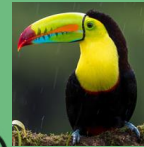
The Colosseum in Rome, Italy was a huge arena used for entertainment in Roman times.

Canterbury is a fantastic city with lots of amazing things to see and do. Open your eyes wide when you're out and about and report back!



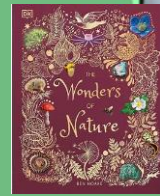
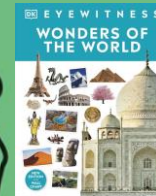
## Capital Cities
