Convert mixed numbers to improper fractions and improper fractions to mixed numbers. Equivalent fractions on a number line. Equivalent fraction families. Add two or more fractions. Add fractions and mixed numbers. Subtract two fractions. Subtract from whole amounts and from mixed numbers

Write 2Logo instructions to create letter shapes.

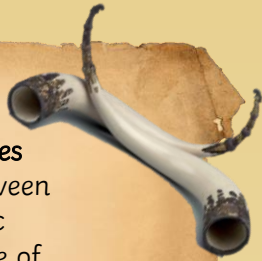
Use the Repeat command in 2Logo to create shapes.
