Throw the Dice

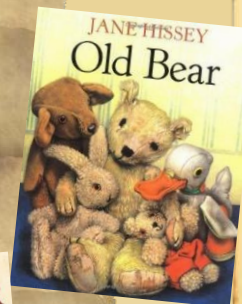
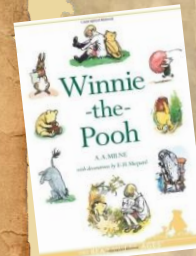
Have a go at playing some traditional board games. Here's a few for you to try:

Design some fabulous new outfits for a teddy or doll. How about for different seasons and occasions?

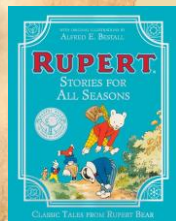
Find out what games your parents and grandparents played and report back.
